

## Circular Flag Book by Mary Conley

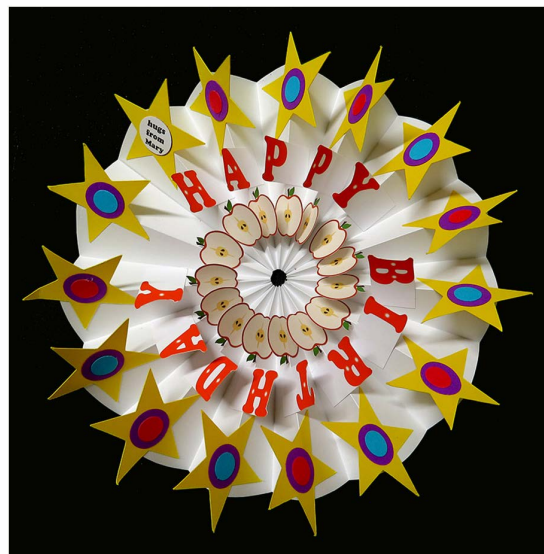
I've invented a circular flag book that is easy to make. Decorating is up to you but I'll send you the patterns I used in making the birthday card just in case you'd like to make it.

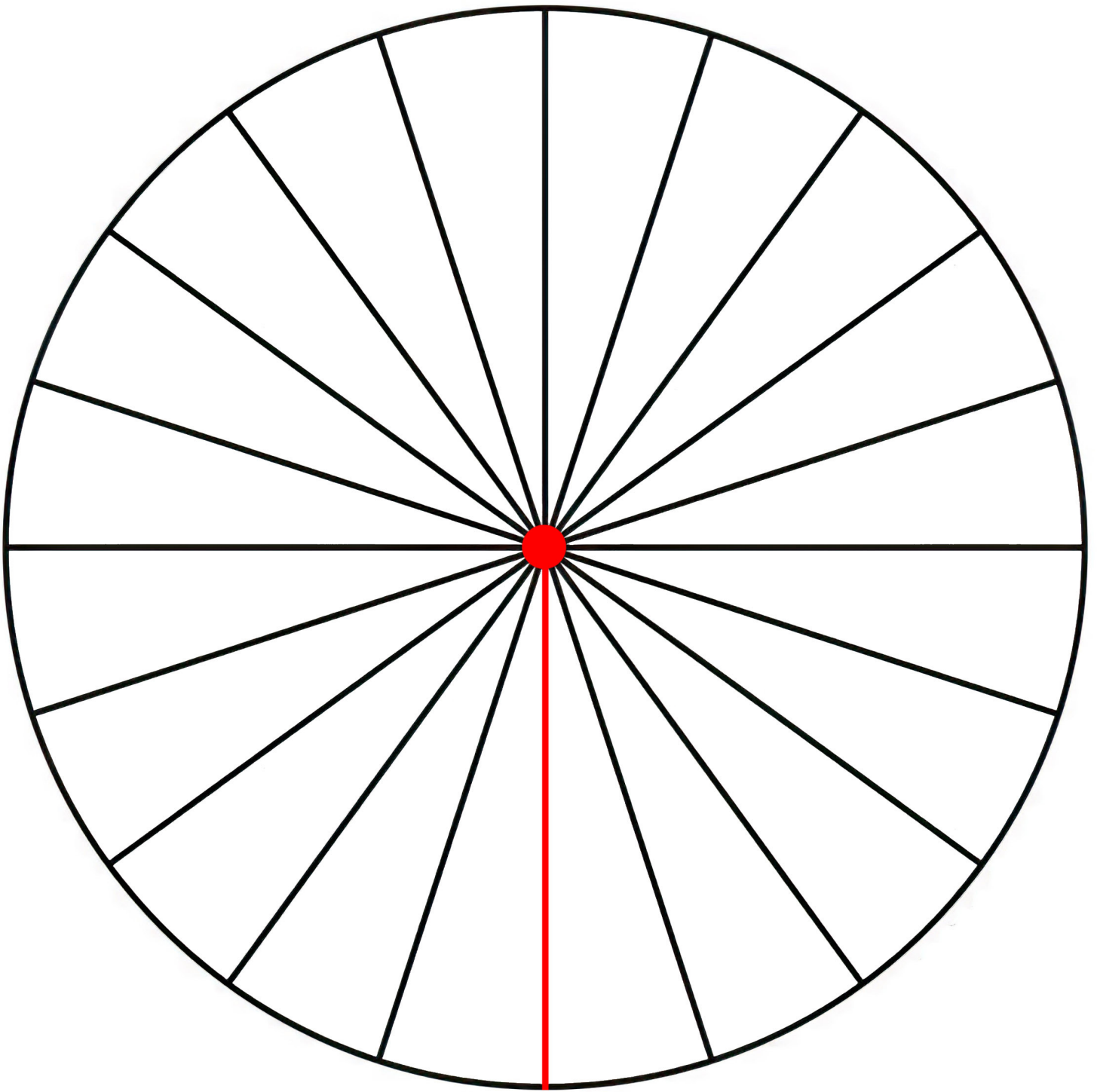
### Supplies

bone folder, scoring tool, ruler, glue stick or PVA and brush, Xacto knife, scissors, cutting mat, and one Velcro dot.

### Suggested decoration:

The participants will be supplied with printouts of the background circles, the lettering ( "happy birthday"), stars to cut out and decorate ahead of time and a pattern of a box to put it in. (The 2 circles should be cut out of light weight card stock or similar material that is easy to fold). Please decorate your stars, ahead of time. You'll need 15 of them. I used 2 punches, 1 inch and 3/4 inch, to cut out circles for this purpose. In addition you will need 15 card stock circles (3/4 inch diameter) for the inner row.

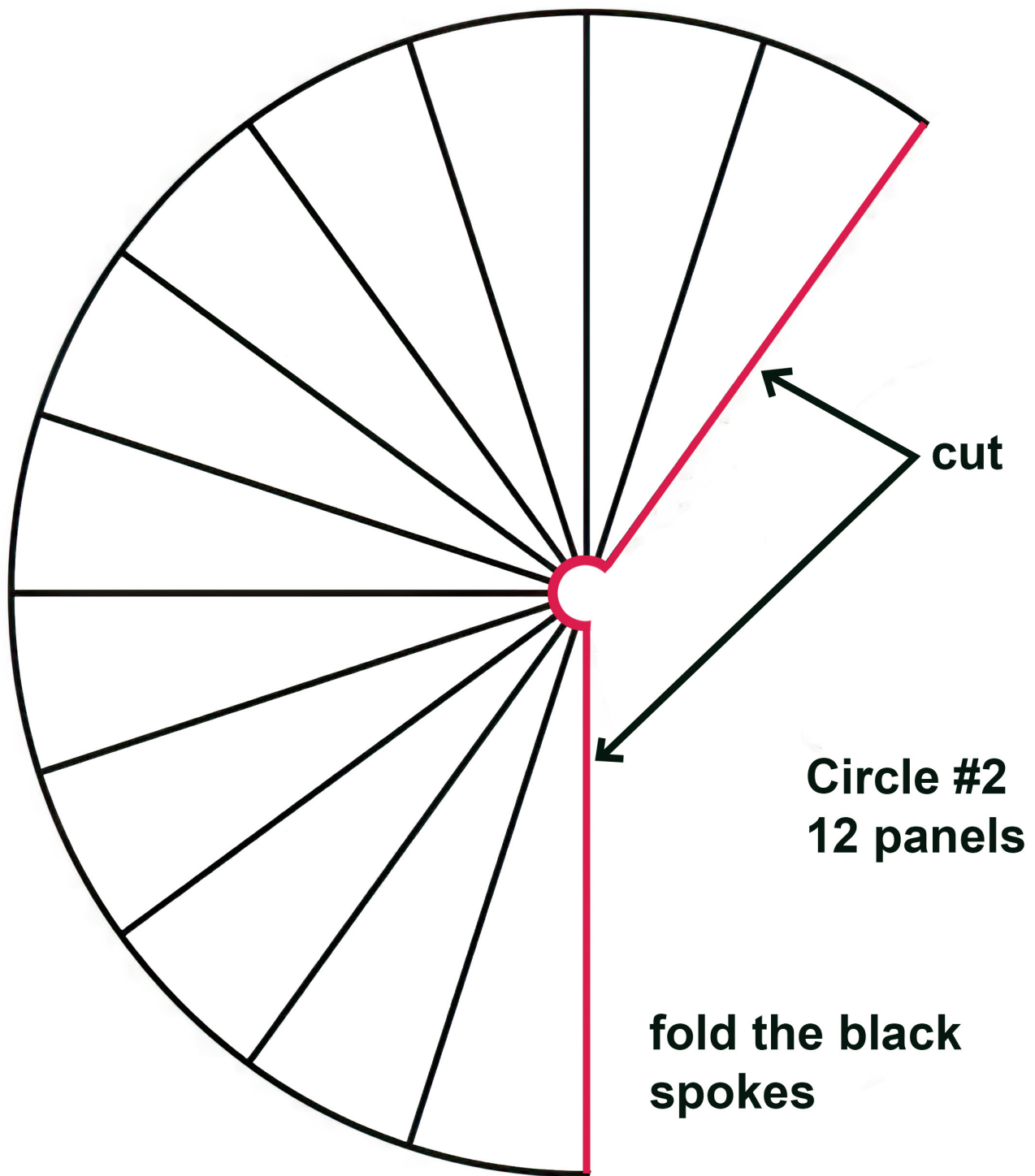




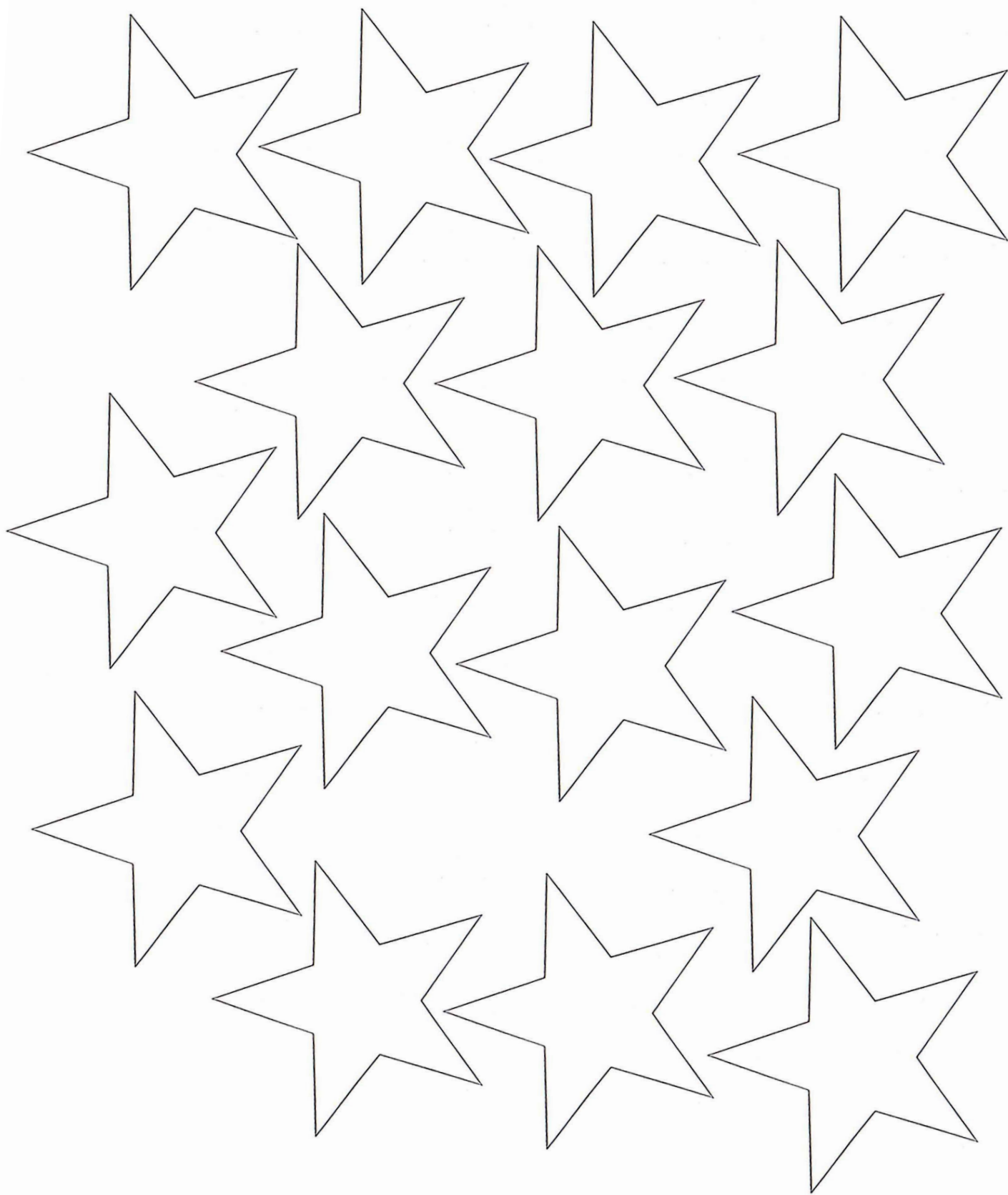
## INSTRUCTIONS FOR CIRCULAR FLAG BOOK

Print the 2 circles on light weight card or index paper. The circles are approximately 7.5 inches in diameter.

Cut out the two circles including the red lines. Don't worry if the center circle is not precise.

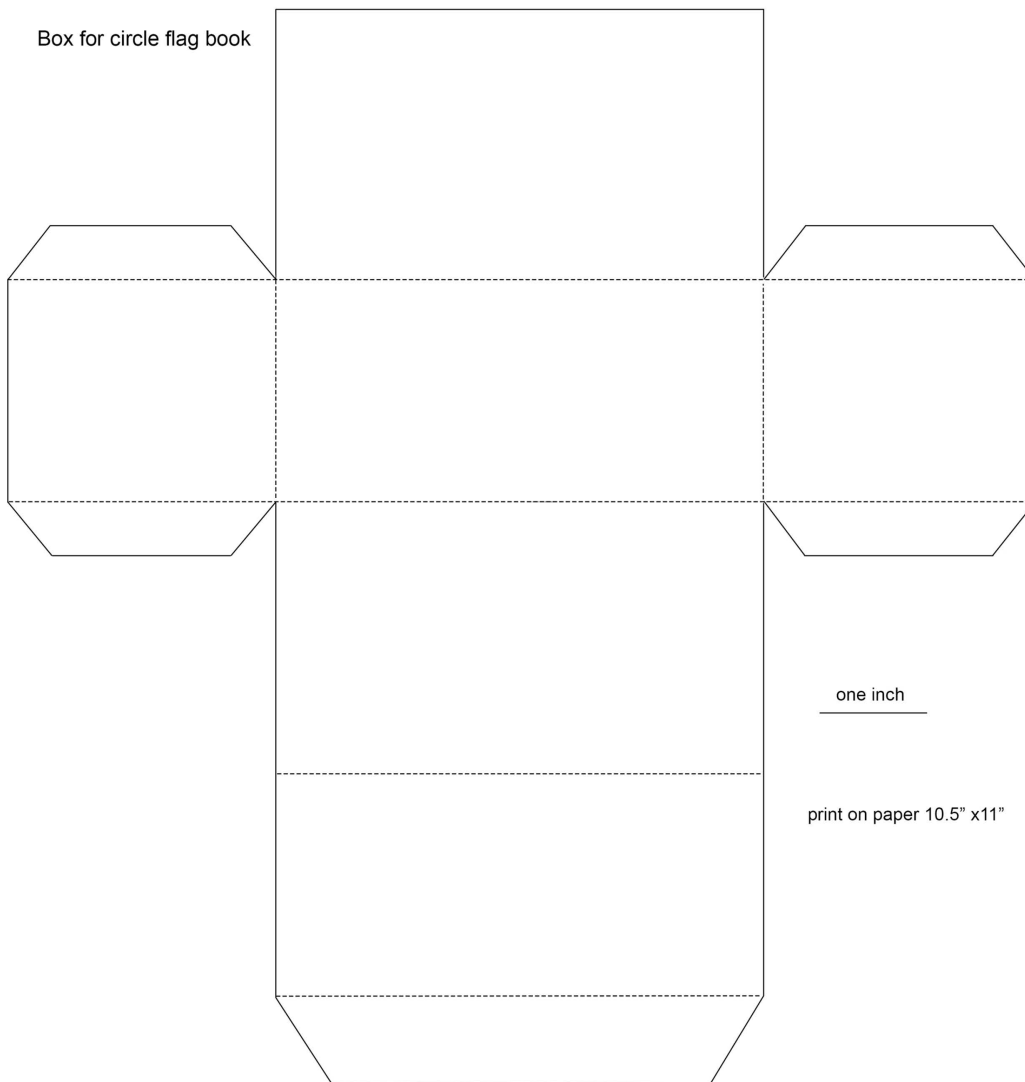


Score the black spokes and then fold accordion style for both circles. The two circles are the glued together at one end. A velcro dot is used to close the other end.
