

Basic Tunnel Book




What you need:

- 3 x 5 photo printed out on photo paper, brochure paper or cardstock. Cut out leaving 1/2" margin on the top and bottom and 1" margin on each side. The photo should be a background photo, showing something in the distance. This page should measure 4" x 7".
- Three additional things for the foreground, of varying sizes. "Thing" 1 that's the closest to you should be the largest. "Thing" 2 should be slightly smaller and "Thing" 3 should be the smallest. All three things should be larger than what's shown in your background photo. These three things should be cut out leaving a 1/2" tab for each one where the "thing" will attach to the frames.
- Two pieces of cardstock cut to 4" x 6" and one piece cut to 4" x 7". These are the page frames.
- Two additional pieces of cardstock cut to 4" x 6". These are the side pieces.
- Ruler
- Xacto knife
- Scoring board OR straight edge and stylus
- Double sided tape
- Bone folder
- Small weight




1. On the two inner page frames, measure $1/2''$ on each side of the plain cardstock. On the larger front frame, measure $1''$ on each side and $1/2''$ from the top and bottom. Cut out the inside leaving a frame on each one.



2. Attach the $1/2''$ tabs of the three "things" to each page, one to each of the plain frames. Arrange them using the background photo as a reference. The small and medium "things" should be attached to the $4'' \times 6''$ frames and the largest to the $4'' \times 7''$ frame.



3. Measure and score the side piece. Score first at $1''$ from the left and right sides, then every $1/2''$ between these. Number these from 1 to 10. Fold each into a $1''$ accordion fold using a bone folder.



4. Use the double sided tape to attach the pages and page frames to the sides, working from back to front. The two large sections (#1 and #10) should be pointed towards the center. The photo is attached to the side sections that are labeled #10. Tape sections #7 and #8 together so that it creates a tab that points toward the center then attach the frame with the smallest "thing". Next, tape sections #3 and #4 together to create a tab then attach the frame with the middle sized "thing". Attach the final frame (the page that measures 4" x 7") to the sections marked #1.
